This year, our club gave \$2,000 to the Escuela de Educacion Especial de San Miguel de Allende, Mexico. This is a private School for the Deaf in San Miguel de Allende started by one of the Rotary Clubs in that town. This is the third year we have supported this school. In year one, we obtained a District 6970 grant and with our funds were able to purchase a variety of equipment to teach vocational skills to the teenage students valued at \$8,000. Last year, we gave them \$2,000 to purchase laptops for the older students to learn academic skills.
