Meetings are held weekly and including fellowship, information and interesting speakers on various topics important to our members and community.

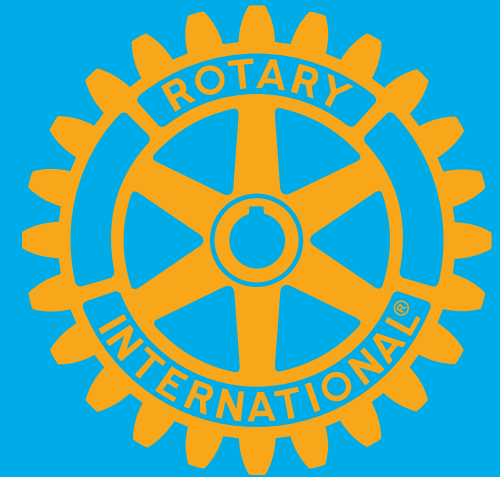
