- 7. Review with mentor or club's Red Badge Coordinator the Process of Proposing a New Member. Work with mentor to propose a new member.
- 8. Make up a meeting at another club with mentor.
- 9. Mentor reviews orientation kit with new member.
- 10. Attend one of the following: club fellowship, project workday, district conference, district assembly or other district meeting.
- 11. Update Club WEB site with Secretary

The Red Badge coordinator will:

- 1. Assign a mentor to work with you as a new member.
- 2. Assign New Member to a committee.
- 3. Assist in the completion of the Red Badge program.
