



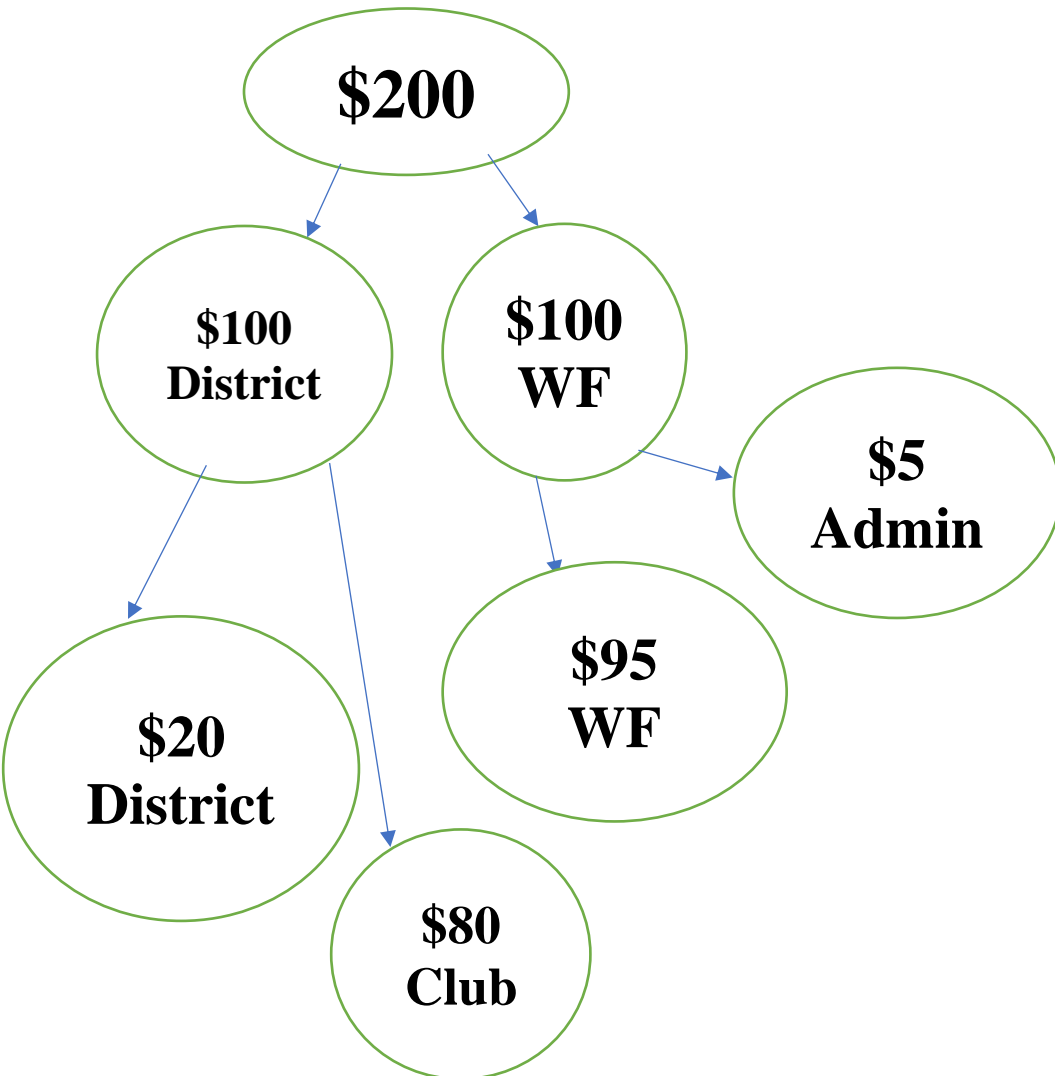

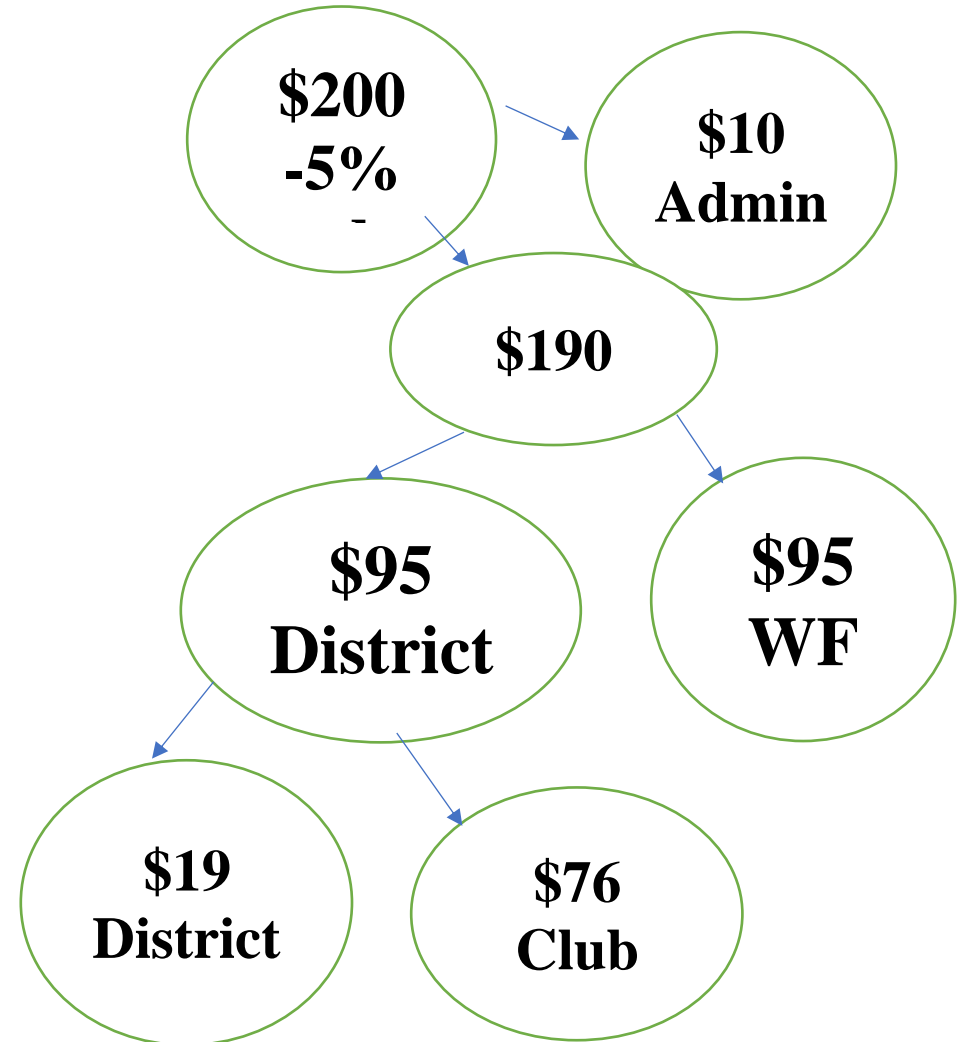

Distribution of Funds - Now

(after three years) With District 6980 Revenue Sharing

Now

- Clubs receive 40% of their total Annual Fund contributions from (three years ago)
- **$\$200 \times .40 = \80 DDF (to the club)**

Distribution of Funds July 1, 2021



July 1, 2021

- The Rotary Foundation subtracts 5% from the total Annual Fund contributions from the club leaving 95% to work with
- Clubs then receive 40% of this ADJUSTED total Annual Fund amount from (three years ago)

- **$(\$200 \times .95) \times .40 = \76DDF**
 - This amounts to the club receiving 38% of their total Annual Fund contributions instead of 40%
