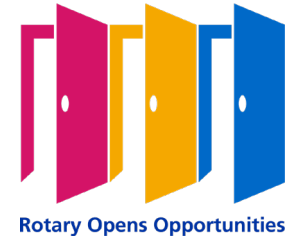
# Humanitarian & Educational Projects

- Based on a community assessment
- Strategically focused, high impact
- Long term, sustainable



# Vocational Training Team

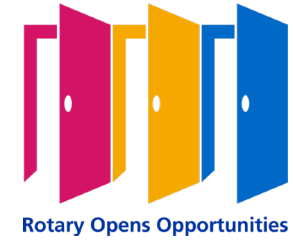


- Builds skills within a community by local training
- Teach local professionals about a particular field
- Supporting groups of professionals traveling aboard for study on their profession





# Scholarship



- Global Grant Scholars must support an Area of Focus and be for graduate level study.
- Global Grant Scholars must have a Rotary Club or Rotary District in the country or geographical area where the study will take place.

# Global Grant Process



- The Club President (2020-21) and Club President Elect (President in 2021-2022) must sign the District Memorandum of Understanding.
- A club member that will be working on grants must attend the District Global Grant Workshop. Attendance can be fulfilled by watching the recorded workshop which will be available within fourteen (14) days after the completion of the workshop.
- There is no Rotary Foundation match for cash donations to a Global Grant. DDF donations are matched dollar for dollar.
- Global Grants from our district will originate from clubs and an individual club will be the sponsor.
- A club considering the development of a proposed Global Grant should make early contact with the district's Foundation Committee and Global Grant Subcommittee for assistance.
