## Headline: Rotary Club of College Park Support College Park Restaurants program exceeds \$5000

Lead: Orlando, FL – The Rotary Club of College Park is proud to announce that the special fundraising effort to support local restaurants in the College Park area and to support staff, faculty and students at area schools has just passed the \$5000 mark in the purchase of gift cards from local area restaurants.

The club, through its Rotary Club of College Park Foundation, has received donations of over \$2500 to the Foundation to purchase gift cards from area restaurants. The cards are being donated to College Park public schools for distribution to students, faculty and staff that are working during this period or have special need for help. All donations to this effort (up to \$5,000) are matched by the Foundation and all funds raised go to the purchase of the gift cards. Thanks to the generous donation from Taste of College Park sponsors and members of the club, the amount to be spent on gift cards during the first three weeks of the program exceeds \$5000. The program will continue until local restaurants are back open to 100% capacity.
