New Little Free Library™ Opening in Pine Hills by Rotary eClub of Florida

2016 December 5—Orlando, Florida, USA: Midwife Jennie Joseph's <u>Easy Access Women's Health Clinic</u> is the site of a new public <u>Little Free Library</u>™. Rotarian Joseph is hosting a ribbon cutting for the portable bookcase at her clinic on December 16, 2016 at 10:00 a.m.

The Easy Access Women's Health Clinic, at 6889 W Colonial Dr (at Hiawassee Rd), is providing a cabinet of various reading materials from infant through adult levels on many topics. Pregnancy and nutrition books, Cookbooks, children's stories, magazines on nature, technology books, career building, and other topics will be free to borrow and return.

Joseph believes that, "Education and literacy are vital for peace, health improvement, adequate childcare, career development, and community wellness. Adding easy access to learning, reading, and career enhancing books will improve neighborhoods throughout the area."

"Normal library requirements of identification, transportation, return deadlines, fines, Wi-Fi, and/or computer hardware are not needed to use the Rotary provided Little Free Library™ at the Easy Access Women's Health Clinic" commented Phyllis 'Dr.O.' M Olmstead, EdD. This is the third Little Library provided through the Rotary eClub of Florida by Dr.O. since October. The first is at Alonso Medical & Wellness in Seminole County on SR 436 at Pearl Lake Causeway. The second is in Oley's Kitchen & BBQ in Orange County on SR 441 in Rosemont.

Jennie Joseph's midwifery office, The Birth Place, is located in Winter Garden, Florida. The Pine Hills office provides women's healthcare in Orange County. Her model of healthcare, The JJ Way®, provides an evidence-based system to deliver mother child healthcare services which improve health, reduce costs and produce better outcomes all round.
