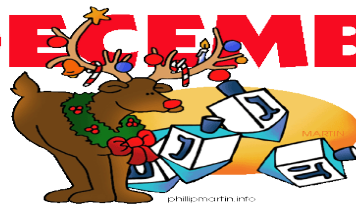
Fundraising
