An Escambia DMV Agent will call and use that code word before verifying payment information. Choose "Pre-sale Vouchers". Click "Select Pre-sale Voucher", scroll down and choose "Rotary" Fill out everything and click "submit" You can also personalize your tag.

Once we reach 3000 presale vouchers, FloridaDMV will distribute tags.
