“Please note awards, for Membership growth and retention along with Foundation giving, will be based upon the fiscal Rotary year of July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024 and will be awarded at the District Workshop in the fall of 2024.

This year’s awards will be based upon a point system and we will trust you will use “The Four Way Test” when submitting your responses.

Awards Levels: All criteria are evenly weighted. In order to qualify for each award level, clubs must complete the indicated number of criteria.

- Bronze 21 - 25
- Silver 26 - 30
- Gold level 31 - 35
- Platinum level 36 - 40
