We need to know the number of students so that supplies can be ordered. Once you have determined how many students you are willing to sponsor, I am asking you to **contact your VOCATIONAL SCHOOL GUIDANCE COUNSELOR** and let them know your number. They will then begin the selection process for the students. If the school cannot find enough students for your club, your money will be refunded. However, you may wish to instruct the school to select a student, in that case, from another community. Remember, not all communities have Rotary clubs. If there is no Rotary Club good students from that area are not eligible. If a student is registered and simply does not "show up" the registration money cannot be returned since food and supplies have already been ordered.
