Originally from Long Island, NY, Tom moved to Frie in 1988 to work for GE Transportation Systems after previous assignments with GE Power Systems, GE Aerospace and Ingersoll-Rand Company in various locations. In addition to earning a degree in Marine/Mechanical Engineering from the State

University of New York Maritime College, he also earned an MBA from Penn State Behrend, and achieved officer status in the US Navy, Merchant Marine and Coast Guard.

In 1993, Tom left GE to pursue his dream of owning a business and founded Professional Development Associates which has become a leading business and real estate development company. 
