Maestro Daniel Meyer

Erie Philharmonic's Music Director



As Music Director of the Erie Philharmonic,
Daniel Meyer has reinvigorated both orchestras
with innovative programming and a dedication
to create and sustain enthusiastic audiences
for classical music. In his continuing commitment to Erie and northwest Pennsylvania,
Meyer develops new youth concerts for thousands of area schoolchildren, appears as a
regular guest on WQLN radio, JET and WICU
TV, frequently presents to local schools, civic
clubs, ExpERIEnce Children's Museum, and
continues to broaden the Philharmonic's reach
through performances at Edinboro University,
the Erie Art Museum, and the Academy Theatre

in Meadville. His monthly presentations at Springhill are popular community events, where he introduces the coming symphonic concert's music.

For the 16-17 season, Meyer inaugurates the Philharmonic's new Beethoven 4/4 project, a four-year festival featuring the great symphonic, concerto and choral works of Beethoven leading up to Beethoven's 250th birthday. The 103rd season begins with a special outdoor performance of Beethoven's Fifth Symphony on Perry Square and ends with the music of Vaughan Williams and vocalists from the Pittsburgh Opera.

A passionate advocate for music education and community engagement, Meyer has developed a series of youth concerts based on popular children's books to promote music and literacy. He was awarded the Bank of America Award for Excellence in Orchestra Education for his groundbreaking work with the Pittsburgh Symphony and has also appeared as a guest lecturer at Carnegie Mellon's Tepper School of Business.

A native of Cleveland, Meyer studied conducting at the Hochschule für Musik in Vienna as a Rotary Ambassadorial Scholar. He is a graduate of Denison University, where he recently received the Distinguished Alumnus Citation and the University of Cincinnati College-Conservatory of Music. He composed and conducted works for ensembles at both schools, including a Stabat Mater for soprano, chorus and orchestra. At Boston University, Meyer received the Orchestral Conducting Honors Award, and last May he received an honorary doctorate from Edinboro University.
