End Polio Now



Dr. Doupe is a retired physician who practiced in Erie until 2000. He is originally from Seattle, Washington. He did his undergraduate studies at Johns Hopkins University and medical school training at the University of Washington School of Medicine in Seattle. After serving as a flight surgeon in the Air Force stationed in Japan in 1966 to 1969, he studied at the Magee Woman's Hospital at the University of Pittsburgh. He practiced Obstetrics and Gynecology in Erie from 1972 to 1990. He served as the Vice President for Medial Affairs at Hamot Medial Center from 1986 to 1995. Later, he received his Masters in Public Health at the University of Pittsburgh School of Public Health.

He is a fellow of the American College of Obstetrics and Gynecology as well as a Fellow of the American College of Physician Executives.

He moved to Erie in 1972. He has been a member of the Erie Rotary Club for 43 years. He has been married to Beverly Anne for 54 years and they have had three children who have given them five grandchildren.

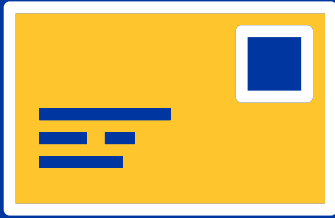
