Brian Waugaman was originally hired as Chief Technology Officer for Erie School Employees Federal Credit Union in 1998.

He maintained the dual role of Chief Technology/Operations Officer in 2007 until being promoted to Chief Operations Officer after successfully serving as credit union's lead project manager during the organizations core database conversion completed in September 2007.

In May 2008, Brian achieved his Certified Chief Executive designation by completing requirements of the Credit Union Executives Society's CEO Institute, attending sessions at the University of Pennsylvania's Wharton School of Executive Education, Cornell University's Johnson School of Business and the University of Virginia's Darden School of Business.

He has been Erie Federal Credit Union's Chief Executive Officer since March 2014.

Brian serves as a Board member for First Heritage Mortgage Services, Members Business Financial Services and Pennsylvania Credit Union Service Centers, Inc.

Most recently Brian was appointed to CUNA's Credit Union Powers Subcommittee providing necessary feedback on legislative and regulatory proposals affecting the credit union industry.




