Still University, Arizona School of Health Sciences; a Master of Science degree (M.S.) in Audiology from Clarion University of Pennsylvania; and a Bachelor of Arts degree (B.A.) in Psychology from Allegheny College. She is a Fellow of the American Academy of Audiology and earned her Certificate of Clinical Competence from

the American Speech-Language-Hearing Association. Additionally, she is a member of the Pennsylvania Academy of Audiology. 
