## Carolyn Taylor Dyslexia





Carolyn Taylor has been working to raise awareness about dyslexia since her own son was diagnosed in 2006. Finding no resources in her community to teach him to read, she sought training and remediated him herself. After repeated requests from his school to help with other students, and countless requests from parents desperate to find reading help for their children, she opened her own business in 2007. Carolyn has taken over 100 students of all ages from illiteracy to fluency. She achieved certification in the renowned Barton Reading and Spelling System in 2008. In addition to running her own private tutoring practice, Carolyn has assisted internationally recognized dyslexia expert, Susan Barton, in teaching the graduate level course, "Tutoring People with Dyslexia" and currently acts as a consultant to several area agencies, helping them bring evidenced based reading instruction to their students. For the past three years, she has volunteered to coordinate a tutoring program at McKinley Elementary in the Erie School District.


