She previously served the Erie region in the U.S. House of Representatives, representing the 3rd Congressional District of Pennsylvania. She was a member of the National Association of Counties- National League of Cities Task Force on the Opioid Epidemic, and was appointed by Gov. Tom Wolf to Pennsylvania's Local Government Advisory Committee. She also serves on the board of County
