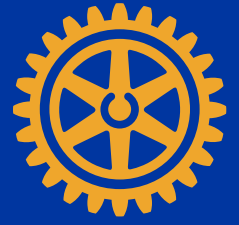

Robert Chatfield

Free to Choose Network



Robert Chatfield is President and CEO of Free To Choose Network, a global media organization that produces documentary videos and classroom teaching units. This company originally produced the world-famous 10-part series Free To Choose featuring Nobel Laureate Milton Friedman. The program was originally broadcast in 1980.

The Free To Choose Network uses accessible and entertaining media to build popular support for ideas championed by Milton Friedman and others: that the greatest advancements in human well-being result when people have the maximum amount of personal, economic and political freedom.

Mr. Chatfield has spent most of his career bridging the worlds of business with academia. He worked in numerous financial management roles for organizations ranging from start-up companies to publicly traded corporations. For over 20 years, he has also served as an adjunct professor for several institutions including Syracuse University, Suffolk University and the University of New England, including a one-year stint as visiting professor at Suffolk's campus in West Africa.

Mr. Chatfield lives in Cape Elizabeth, Maine with his two children and their menagerie of pets. He is an active member of the Portland Rotary Club of Maine and has participated in several humanitarian missions with Rotary International.

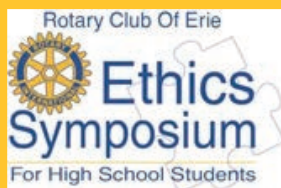

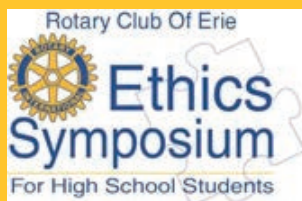
