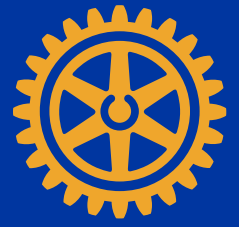

## Char Mashyna Lake Erie Arboretum



Char Mashyna has been the Director of LEAF, the Lake Erie Arboretum at Frontier Park since January 2014. As director, she is responsible for the daily operations of the arboretum including fundraising, membership, facility rental, grounds, and finance and is the liaison with the City of Erie. During her tenure at LEAF, Char has overseen the growth of the organization to now include a program

director and summer grounds keeper as well as grounds improvements including the installation of a green roof on the LEAF Education Center and a new pathway.

Prior to joining LEAF, Char was the Executive Director of Arts Erie, now known as Erie Arts & Culture, and held various positions at PNC, National City, Integra and Pennbank including Vice President and Regional Executive, Private Client Group. A graduate of Wheaton College in Norton, MA, she is a Board member and past President of the Millcreek Education Foundation which supports the students and faculty of Millcreek Township schools and is a corporator of the Erie Cemetery Association.

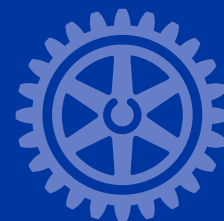
