### Dr. David Hyland Mercyhurst University, NE



Dr. David C. Hyland is vice president for Mercyhurst North East, where he oversees the North East campus of Mercyhurst University as well as its satellite campuses at Corry and the Booker T. Washington Center in Erie. In addition to directing the academic enterprise, he manages the administrative side of the house, including Admissions and Financial Aid, IT, Police and Safety, Student Life, Athletics, Campus Ministry, the Bookstore, and Parkhurst Dining Services.

Dr. Hyland began his career at Mercyhurst in 1995, holding a joint appointment in the departments of anthropology/archaeology and biology, and was promoted to full professor in 2008. He has taught 3,600 students and published or presented more than 100 articles, book chapters, papers, reviews and reports. He has managed numerous labs, the biology department, and the former School of Health Professions and Public Health at Mercyhurst.

As the top administrator of Mercyhurst North East, Dr. Hyland is committed to creating transformational opportunities for students who otherwise might not get the chance. He is here today to tell you much more, particularly highlighting the new Women and Children Program the university will launch this summer to help single mothers get a college education and better their lives and those of their children.

## Rotary International Tree Project

**Rotary International President Ian Riseley** challenged every Rotary club to make a difference by planting a tree for each of its members between the start of the Rotary year on July 1 and Earth day on April 22, 2018.


We are participating in the District Governor's Tree Project and the trees have been given to the Club. We received 160 trees (80 each) from Musser Forests in Indiana, PA on Friday.

Our club has chosen two types of trees, white flowering dogwood trees 1 yr old 10" tall and red maple (acer rubrum) trees 3 yr old 8-18" tall. All are bare rooted and will need to be planted rather quickly.

Not all the trees have been spoken for at this time so if anyone from the club would like a tree for themselves or knows of an agency that is interested in some let me know.

Also volunteers may be needed to plant them if an agency needs assistance with the digging.
