What is the... PAUL HARRIS FELLOW RECOGNITION

Although his intention was only to enhance his business connections and make new friends, as the founder of the first Rotary Club in Chicago in 1905, Paul Harris is recognized worldwide as a vital humanitarian. While Rotarians are generally proud of their collective accomplishments, individual donors of \$1,000 or more to the Annual Programs Fund, PolioPlus, or the Humanitarian Grants Program, or people who have that amount contributed in their name, can be recognized as Paul Harris Fellows by Rotary International. Each new Paul Harris Fellow receives a commemorative certificate and a pin. The Paul Harris Fellow recognition began in 1957 with 12 Fellows named. By 2006, there were 1 million worldwide.

L.T. Briggs' 1934 writings tell us that, "Additional contributions [to the Foundation] came from various sources until the time of Paul Harris' death in 1947, when as a memorial to him, Rotarians worldwide have since contributed" toward "Paul Harris Fellow Recognition." To date, the Erie Club has produced 125 Paul Harris Fellows, many of these "repeat offenders."

In 1981, the Erie Club began the practice of naming one member a year a Paul Harris Fellow based upon their service, beginning with contemporary Club Secretary Charles Yartz (1959-60), who maintained that responsibility for over 11 years from 1968 until 1981, with the Club donating the requisite \$1,000 to Rotary International on his behalf. Current Secretary and See-Way Editor Dick DeLuca was so honored on the 10th anniversary of his weekly effort in 2007.

-Ceremony of the -**Incoming Presiding Erie Rotary President**

There seems to be guite a bit of lore surrounding the "Curtze Diamond" that is presented to the incoming Presiding Erie Rotary President. A few years ago Norm Stark first asked if I could appraise and verify the diamond before handing the diamond to the outgoing president. He also asked me to share how the "Curtze" Diamond had grown over the last year". I was a bit curious, diamonds don't grow once mined, so I knew this would be a fun ceremony to be part of and I'm honored each year when I'm asked to participate.

I'm sure most members in our club have never seen the Curtze Diamond - here's the scoop...

District 7280

The diamond was cut in the early 1900's and was set into a 14Karat yellow gold medal/pendant that is the Rotary logo. The diamond is approximately 1/5ct and set in the center of the pendant; the back is engraved: EH CURTZE To Presiding Presidents 6-24-31. This currently is on a gold filled tie chain. The approximate replacement value is \$1,050.00, but the sentiment and history are irreplaceable. This piece has been handed down for 87 years, oh the stories that go with it...I can only imagine. It would be great to hear more!
