Scott Bayline Rotary District 7280 Governor



Scott was born in Bellefonte, PA and grew up in Port Allegany. He graduated from Port Allegany Jr./Sr. High School in 1982 and Rochester Institute of Technology in 1989 with a Bachelors degree in Accounting.

Scott began working at Xerox Corporation in August of 1985. He held several marketing and pricing positions in Rochester, NY and the Contract Manager position in the New England Customer Business unit. He resigned from Xerox in October of 2000 to join his father, J. Michael Bayline in the family

insurance and financial planning business.

In 2001, Scott's father, a long time Rotarian, encouraged him to join Rotary. Scott became Treasurer and held that position as well as Foundation Chairman for a number of years. In 2009, Scott became President of the Rotary club of Port Allegany. After his term he resumed the Foundation chairman's role for the club. He was appointed Assistant Governor in 2011 and held that position for six years and acted as AG Coordinator for two years. Scott and his family have hosted four exchange students in addition to numerous Group Study Exchange team members.

Scott is also active in other community organizations. He currently serves as Vice Chairman of the McKean County Housing Authority Board, Vice Chairman of the McKean County Redevelopment Authority Board and was previously Chairman of both Boards. Scott served as a Board member of CARE for Children for nine years completing his third term in 2016. He also enjoys golfing and was a Board member of the Pennhills club for 6 years.

In addition to Golf, Scott enjoys Hockey, specifically the Hershey Bears and Penn State Nittany Lions games. Scott married Paula in 1996 and they have a daughter Haley. 
