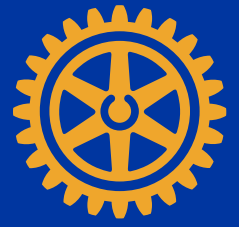

Chief Medical Officer & VP of Medical Affairs



Gregory Beard, D.O., is the chief medical officer and vice-president, medical affairs at UPMC Hamot. He is a board-certified surgeon and is also the medical director of Trauma and Surgical Critical Care at UPMC Hamot.

Dr. Beard completed a fellowship in trauma/surgical critical care at UPMC Presbyterian. He earned his medical degree

from Kansas City University of Medicine and Biosciences and completed a surgical residency at Kennedy Memorial Hospital in New Jersey. Dr. Beard joined the UPMC Hamot staff in 1994 and is part of the surgical and trauma team at Great Lakes Surgical Specialists.

David Gibbons

President of UPMC Hamot

David P. Gibbons, M.H.A., R.N., is the president of UPMC Hamot. Gibbons had been executive vice president and chief operating officer at UPMC Hamot since 2012. Beginning in 2009, he also has served in the role of president, UPMC Northwest in Venango County.



At UPMC Hamot, Gibbons has had executive oversight of the majority of Hamot's clinical service lines and has cultivated numerous business and community partnerships to enhance patient care. He was instrumental in the planned construction of a new \$111 million patient tower to be completed in 2020; establishing Hamot's kidney transplant program, the first in the region and the first UPMC transplant program in the U.S. outside of Pittsburgh; and the Magnet designation for the nursing staff, the highest and most prestigious distinction a health care organization can receive for nursing excellence.
