Mr. Harris is currently the President and Chief Executive Office of All About Character, Inc. Prior to his current position, Mr. Harris served the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania as a State Trooper for 20 years. These situations instilled a passion in Mr. Harris to help our youth and give back to his community by creating a unique program called Character: Be About It/Troopers Teaching Students.


