Ms. Chanel M. Cook currently serves as the Outreach Services Manager for the Erie County Public Library where she is responsible for public relations, communication and partnership development.

She previously served as the Administrative Officer for Erie County Executive Kathleen Dahlkemper and Director of Administration, Mr. Gary N. Lee, where she was responsible for coordinating internal and external communication and constituent relations.

She earned a Master of Science in Organizational Leadership from Mercyhurst University in spring 2017. In addition, Chanel is a Cum Laude graduate and holds a Bachelor of Arts

degree in Political Science from Gannon University – where she served as a SCUSA delegate at USMA, West Point. Ms. Cook is also a graduate of the 2015 inaugural class of the Erie County Civic Leadership Academy facilitated by the Jefferson Educational Society.

Ms. Cook has served in the public sector for nearly two decades. Most notably, serving the residents of the Third Congressional District as a District Representative under the leadership of Congressman Phil English and Kathleen Dahlkemper respectively. She facilitated resolutions for thousands of constituents, coordinated service academy appointments – earning an honorary admissions counselor designation, and was responsible for special projects and various congressional outreach programs.

Ms. Cook also had the privilege of serving New Americans as the first Refugee Health Manager for the Erie County Department of Health where she spearheaded improved relations with the Office of Refugee Resettlement and the PA Department of Health.

Chanel is an accomplished, efficient and engaged problem-solver. She has an exceptional ability to manage projects and personalities to increase collaboration and cooperation. Ms. Cook has earned a reputation as an insightful communicator with solid judgement. She is passionate about issues of equity, education and community engagement.

She is the proud Vice Chair of the Erie Philharmonic Board of Governors, serves on the board of directors for the United Way of Erie County, the WQLN Community Advisory Board, and the Cultures, Arts, Festivals and Events (CAFÉ) of Erie. This year, she will serve as the Vice President for the Family District at Celebrate Erie. Ms. Cook was recently appointed by the County Executive to serve on the New Horizons Task Force for Erie Arts and Culture. She previously served as a Vice Chair for the Greater Erie Community Action Committee (GECAC), the Martin Luther King Center, the Northwest PA Regional Planning Commission, and as an Ex Officio Representative on the Erie County Redevelopment Authority.

Recently nominated by Senator Toomey, Ms. Cook will represent northwest PA at the National Security Seminar at the US Army War College in Carlisle this summer.

Ms. Cook is the recipient of the J. Robert Baldwin Award for Service Above Self and a member of the 2016 Erie Reader 40 Under 40 Cohort. She is a leader with vision who consistently exceeds expectations. Chanel has a broad, diverse professional profile that is an asset to the Erie community. The proud mom of a high school senior – soon to be, college freshman at RMU, Chanel has survived the college selection process and plans to enjoying the next several months making memories with her daughter.


