


Rotary Peace Fellow—Wisdom Addo

Erie Rotarian, Joyce Miller, Ph.D* hosted Wisdom during his stay in Erie. Wisdom thanked the Erie Club and all who provided a donation for this service project.

* Joyce Miller attended the 2017 PEACE JAM GHANA conference and saw, firsthand, the power of these conferences for youth in Ghana with respect to their acquiring leadership, as well as peace and conflict resolution skills.
