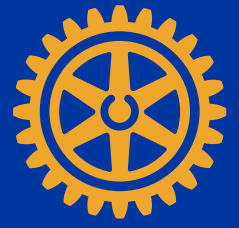

"Getting Health Care Right"



Christopher C. Clark, DO, MHA has been President of Saint Vincent Hospital since June of 2017. Born at Saint Vincent and a lifelong resident of the Erie community, Dr. Clark is a practicing family physician who has served in a number of leadership roles at the hospital over the past decade, including Senior Vice President of Medical Affairs, Chief Quality Officer, and Director of Medical Education.

Dr. Clark has also worked as a medical director for Highmark Inc., responsible for promoting value based strategies and population health interventions to employers.

Active in many community and professional organizations, Dr. Clark serves on the Board of Directors for the United Way, VNA of Erie County, Erie Regional Chamber and Growth Partnership, and the Erie Downtown Development Corporation. He has been active in fundraising for the Children's Miracle Network, the March of Dimes and the American Heart Association. Dr. Clark is a past President and board member for the Erie County Medical Society, and is a member of the American Academy of Family Physicians, American College of Healthcare Executives and Pennsylvania Medical Society.

He earned his undergraduate degree from Boston College, a medical degree from the Philadelphia College of Osteopathic Medicine and completed his residency at Geisinger Medical Center in Danville, Pa. Dr. Clark also received a master of health administration degree from the Pennsylvania State University and a graduate certificate in gerontology from Gannon University.
