

Alcohol and Drug Addiction are very serious, progressive, incurable and potentially fatal diseases. I created CROSSING THE LINE because even with my disease of alcoholism I've been a lucky guy. I haven't lost everything important in my life. Therefore, in retirement, I'm using this opportunity to give back. I want to try and help those, and their families, who suffer from alcohol and drug addiction.
