Each Community School's Lead Partner employs a Director who works closely with the principal and the Community School Leadership Team. The hiring of each Director is made possible through Corporate Partner support.

The Rotary Club of Erie is one of McKinley Elementary School's community partners, providing books for its library, coats for students through funds raised with its Super Bowl pool and many members volunteer in Rotary-sponsored events.

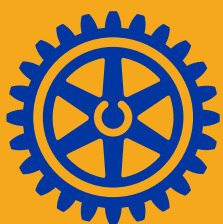

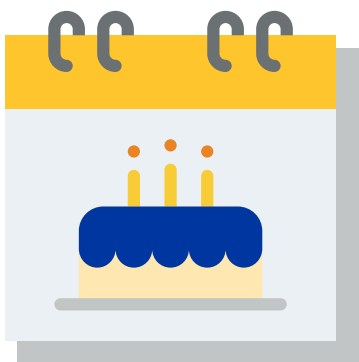
Dennis Lagan reports he is cancer free!

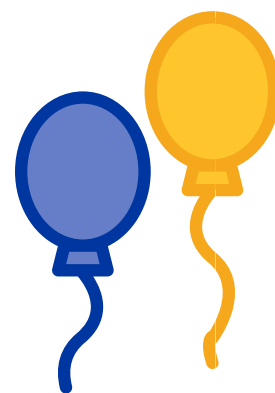

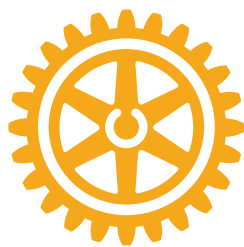
