

In conjunction with this program, we started our Student of the Month Award in 1998 for freshman students. Since then, 169 students have earned this award and have received \$19,000 in United States Savings Bonds or cash.

The Quaker Valley Rotary firmly believes in supporting the young people in our community, and in 2006, did attain a 501c3 tax-exempt status with the Internal Revenue Service. In 2018 we changed our name to Quaker Valley Rotary Foundation. We can now expand the mission of our foundation to other charitable endeavors.

Bands, breweries, local business and vulnerable humans have suffered through Covid. This event has the visibility and comradery needed to jump start recovery.

A little about

Rooted Outreach is fiercely confronting human trafficking, sexual abuse & assault and homelessness right here in our



area through awareness, education & victim support. They provide clothing kits to emergency rooms right here in our area for victims of sexual assault & abuse, human trafficking and trauma.

Why? Hospitals usually don't have clothing for victims after theirs are collected for evidence or destroyed due to a traumatic accident. Without the kits, victims must be sent home in scrubs, mesh undergarments or paper gowns. Rooted Outreach believes these patients should be discharged with dignity.

Event attendees will learn the warning signs, how to report suspicious behaviors and prevention practices.
