

## DISTRICT INTERACT

Nomination forms were emailed to all District 7305 Interact Clubs in August. There have been some changes made to the elections procedures this year by the Dis-

trict's Interact Board of Directors.

VOTE

This year, the terms of five Board Members will be expiring on June 30, 2021. Therefore we need to replace them with individuals who are willing to serve a two-year term that will begin on July 1, 2021 and end on June 30, 2023. Individuals will have to be current freshmen or sophomores at their local high schools and must be "nominated" by their Interact Club. Interact Clubs who currently have a Board Member on the incoming Board of Directors are ineligible to make a nomination this year. Those ineligible to nominate this year are: Greensburg Salem Interact Club, Homer Center Interact Club and Greensburg Central Catholic Interact Club.

Nominations from the Interact Clubs must be RE-CEIVED on or before September 16 to be eligible. Once all nominations have been received a ballot will be created and distributed to all Interact Clubs in District 7305. Each Interact Club is entitled to one (1) ballot.

Once the ballots has been counted the Directorselect will be notified and will meet with the remaining Directors (3) whose terms did not expire this year and they will elect the new Interact District Governor who will serve from July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022. This should all be accomplished by October 15, the date of the District's Interact Conference.


## UNCERTAINTY


