INTERACT DISTRICT CONFERENCE



Interact District Governor rang the bell on Thursday, October 15 and began Interact's annual District Conference with the Pledge of Allegiance, an invocation and the reciting of the Four Way Test.

The Interact Board of Directors was introduced along with the two incoming Directors, Kenzi Rullo from the Derry Area High School Interact Club and Shreya Pant from the North Allegheny High School Interact Club.

Making remarks were Rotary District 7305 District Governor Al DeLucia, District Governor-Elect Vince Costa and District Governor Nominee Marie Fallon.

Colonel Charles W. Anderson, USMC (Retired) delivered the keynote address urging Interactors to follow their dreams and not listen to bureaucrats who say "you can't do that".

Presentations about RYLA by Rotarian Owen P. Standley, Youth Exchange by Past District Governor Tom Fallon and Brother's Brother Foundation by their President Ozzy Samad, Dante Cumachero from LaPaz, Bolivia talked about the International Interact Project involving Interact Clubs from Bolivia, Argentina and Mexico and finally Owen Standley talked about "Owen's Odyssey". A lot of useful information was given.

Mark Barnhart, District Interact Chair reminded everyone about the Cards for Heroes program this Christmas and gave information regarding the
