2023 Chili Cook-Off Contestant Information

Sunday, September 17, 2023 - Noon to 4 PM

We are expecting between 800 and 1,000 chili eaters in attendance again this year and we would like to extend to you the opportunity to participate in our event. This event provides great exposure for your organization and builds goodwill within the community. In addition to the exposure at the event, your organization will be listed in our program and on our website.

Contestants are divided into three categories, professional restaurants, non-food related businesses/individuals, and non-profit organizations. Each chili has two opportunities to win prizes - a Judged Tasting Award and a People's Choice Award. Additionally, we encourage teams to compete for "Best Decorated Booth" by picking a theme and decorating your crew and booth accordingly.

Your Entry Fee Includes: (all applications must include payment with entry form)

- 10x10 booth space including tent, table and 2 chairs
- Two contestant T-shirts. (Additional shirts are available for purchase before and during the Chili Cook-Off.)
- Two adult tasting wristbands. (Additional tickets/wristbands are available for purchase before and during the Chili Cook-Off.)
- Spoons, napkins and tasting cups for public use.
- A participation plaque.

Additional Information

Set up starts at 9:00 AM on the day of the event and must be completed by 11:00 AM. The Judging Competition is from 1:00 - 3:00 PM. Awards will be presented after 4 PM. At a designated time during the Judging Competition, you will be given 10 minutes to prepare a sample of your team's chili to be presented to the judges.
