## Emporium Rotary Community Grant Application 2021-2022

#### Questions 1, 2, 3 & 5:

- 1. The Cameron County Ambulance Service provides emergency services to our county residents and assists other services as needed. They along with other Rural Ambulance Services face the challenge of raising funds to maintain their services. The Emporium Rotary Club would to help purchase 12 IPOD Pelvic Stabilizations Devices (\$134 each). These single use devices provide circumferential compression to patients with suspected pelvic fracture which may reduce blood loss and pain. Pelvic injury is associated with significant risk of mortality and requires urgent care. Pelvic stabilization devices are shown to improve pelvic fracture outcomes. Fall victims, car accidents victims and other pelvic injured patients will benefit from receiving a stabilization device.
- At least three members will be involved in some aspect of this project by contacting the Ambulance Service on what pelvic device they will order, securing funding, presenting the check and follow up when they receive the devices.
   Tonyia Wennin from the Ambulance Service will order the devices and then contact us when they arrive.
- 3. The project will benefit the community by having pelvic stabilization devices available for their emergency. Twelve people will benefit from this project
- 5. Will it be beneficial to all concern? **Yes** To the people who receive a pelvic stabilization device, it could save their lives.

- Club must be current on Rotary International and District dues.

#### B) Club Leadership Responsibilities

- The Rotary Foundation Chair of the Rotary Club of Emporium will be responsible for the management of the club's qualifications and ensure there are financial stewardship measures and proper grant management practices in place.
- Documents will be stored in hard copy by the club's TRF Chairperson. Also, an electronic file of all related documents (preferably in DACdb) will be kept by the TRF Chair and financial records by the Club Treasurer. The Club TRF Chair, Club Treasurer, Club President and the Club Grants Chair will have access to these records.
- If any one of these individuals should leave the club or position for any reason, in a timely manner the club will appoint an individual to replace the person who left. Any replacements must be provided a copy of this document so they will be aware of duties as they relate to the TRF Grants/Monies.

#### C) Financial Management Plan

- The District Community Grant is **reimbursable** after submission of the "Final Report." There is no need to open a separate bank account.
- The Club Treasurer will keep a standard set of accounts related to the Club's District Community Grant(s) and will maintain a record of all receipts in hard copy and electronic copy with access by the Club TRF Chair, Club President and Club Grants Chair.
- A copy of all Bank Statements will be kept both hard copy and electronically.
