1. Briefly describe the proposed project. What will be done, when and where will the project take place, and who will benefit from the project?

Sunbury Wetland Ecological and Educational Park. SWEEP is a safe ecological outdoor area in the City of Sunbury. The grant will be used to purchase educational signs for the park. Each sign will be different Educational material relevant to the Sunbury wetland habitat and Sunbury railroad history. The signs will be displayed along ADA accessible trails within the park.

Dimensions of each sign are 36" wide x 24" high. (Pictures attached) with an aluminum base. Each sign will cost \$500-\$600 each. At the bottom each sign the Rotary symbol and Donated by Sunbury Rotary Club will added.
