Project Title: Binder Lift for Bloomsburg Volunteer Ambulance

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

1. Describe the project. What was done, when, and where did project activities take place?

The Bloomsburg Volunteer Ambulance members were looking to purchase Binder Lift Vests. The Vests prevent injuries to the volunteers. As of 2011, the Institute of Health Metrics and Evaluation found that 80% of the population of our county (Columbia County) are obesity. The Life Vests help get patients safely into the ambulances. One Binder Lift costs \$1,622.

2. Who were the beneficiaries, how were they impacted by this project, and what humanitarian need was met? How many people benefited from this project?

The Bloomsburg Volunteer Ambulance group currently serves Bloomsburg, Espy, Catawissa, Numida, Buckhorn, Nescopeck and surrounding municipalities. The Ambulance volunteers play a key role in medical emergencies in this large rural community serving a total population of over 19,500 people.

3. How many Rotarians participated in the project? What did they do? Please give at least two examples, not including financial support provided to the project.

The Bloomsburg Rotary Club matched the District Foundation Grant by raising money in various fundraisers including selling Rotary calendars as well as selling raffle tickets for a large flat-screen television. The majority of our 37 members participated in the fundraisers.
