Project Title: Bicycle Rodeo May 21, 2022

#### PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

1. Describe the project. What was done, when, and where did project activities take place? Area children (target ages 6 through 12) were invited to attend the Bicycle Rodeo with the purpose of promoting safety in the operation of bicycles in the community. After registration each child was fitted with a new bicycle helmet. They then moved to a station where their bicycle was inspected for air pressure, tightness of the chain, proper seat height, brakes, and general condition. From

- 2. Who were the beneficiaries, how were they impacted by this project, and what humanitarian need was met? How many people benefited from this project? Children in the area were the beneficiaries as they were encouraged to operate their bicycles safely and to always wear a properly fitting helmet. Due to several activities in the area turnout was lower than expected but the remainder of the helmets were given to Kara Bauer, RN, BSN, the Trauma, Outreach and Injury
- 3. How many Rotarians participated in the project? What did they do? Please give at least two examples, not including financial support provided to the project.

Half a dozen Rotarians participated the day of the project. They assisted with setting up the various stations of the skills course. They also manned a station on the skills course, demonstrated the objectives of their station to the participants and scored their performance to ensure they're able to safely handle their bicycle under various conditions.

4. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role?

We were aided by Mary Lakari with the The Pennsylvania Chapter, American Academy of Pediatrics Traffic Injury Prevention Project. She provided direction to the Rotarians on how to set up the skills course and on how to score participant performance. We were also aided by Kara Bauer with Penn Highlands. She led the helmet fitting station based on her prior experience as a nurse.

#### Bicycle Rodeo

#1 continued.. there children were moved through 6 stations where they practiced operating their bikes. Stations included high speed braking, slow speed ride between the lines maneuvering left and right around cones, and passing through a simulated intersection where the children were asked to use the hand signals they had learned. Refreshments and snacks were provided and each child was given a certificate of completion and a ticket to enter a drawing for 1 of 4 bicycles.

#2 continued.. Prevention Coordinator for Penn Highlands, Dubois for use in future programs.

#4 continued.. CNB Bank permitted the use of its employee parking lot, and also provided ez up tents for shade for the registration area, helmet fitting area and the refreshment area.


