PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

1. Describe the project. What was done, when, and where did project activities take place?

1. Fall - donated funds to Garrett County Community Action for senior transport to CARC, a local health and fitness center. Next, Thanksgiving meal, Bingo, door prizes, and a loaf of Pumpkin Bread. Christmas: Seniors were given gift cards for a local fruit market & D.General in hand delivered holiday greeting cards. Spring Fling - Sr. center, with a meal, games, door prizes, and fruit for all.

2. Who were the beneficiaries, how were they impacted by this project, and what humanitarian need was met? How many people benefited from this project?

Local seniors were the beneficiaries by participating in activities that provided opportunity for well balanced meals, fitness opportunities, interaction with others and fun. Humanitarian needs was met by providing healthy meals and beneficial physical activities. Numbers varied by activity - Approx. 150+ (transp. included).

15+ Rotary members assisted with this grant project. Many attended and interacted with the seniors, several made phone calls, others spent time purchasing and securing door prizes, gift cards, packing/preparing baked goods and fruit.

We worked very closely with Garrett County Community Action (GCCA) with the planning of activities (setting up dates and securing the facilities). GCCA provided a safe and secure setting for our seniors.
