Project Title: Free books for preschool and early elementary children

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

- 1. Describe the project. What was done, when, and where did project activities take place? The Milton Rotary Club worked with the librarian at the Milton Public Library to purchase books to be given for free to preschool and early elementary children during library small groups and other activities conducted with community groups by the librarian involving these types of children.
- 2. Who were the beneficiaries, how were they impacted by this project, and what humanitarian need was met? How many people benefited from this project? The many children of the Milton area are the beneficiaries many come from lower socio-economic families who may not have funds to buy extra books for their children especially during the pandemic. Since literacy is one of Rotary's areas of focus, these children will be served. Due to careful use of sales by the company and extra free books which are offered, the librarian, a Rotarian, was able to purchase 378 books for \$603. 378 children will benefit.
- **3.** How many Rotarians participated in the project? What did they do? Please give at least two examples, not including financial support provided to the project. Nine Rotarians participated in printing labels and then attending a "labelling party" on a Saturday morning to identify the books as donated by the Rotary Club of Milton, PA. If the pandemic allows, Rotarians will also help distribute the books at small group sessions.

4. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role? The Milton Public Library was the cooperating organization. The librarian purchased the books and the library board accepted the project.


