1. Briefly describe the proposed project. What will be done, when and where will the project take place, and how many people will benefit from the project? How will the project benefit the community?

We will be purchasing and installing a replacement tube slide (plastic) for the existing playground in the Clearfield area Fairgrounds (Also known as the driving park) The current one is cracked at the bottom and attempts to patch it have not been successful. The playground and slide is used extensively by children ages 3 years to teenagers. The popular slid will be safer and probably last another 20 years.

2. How many club members will participate in the project and in what role? Is there a cooperating organization also involved and what will their role be?

All 18 Rotarians will work to raise funds for this and other club projects by participating in our Radio Day and Pancake dinner. 3 - 4 Rotarians will assist Borough employees install the replacement slide.

We will be partnering with the Borough as they will be ordering the slide and providing the majority of the labor. The club will reimburse the Borough for the cost of the slide.

3. Will the project be completed if less than requested funds are granted?

If yes, will the project be modified if this occurs, and if so, how?

Yes the project will be completed without modification. Doing so would mean limiting other projects and activities such as RYLA, and Scholarship Amounts.

4. How does this project reflect the mission of The Rotary Foundation?

Even though it is a small project it will be seen by the community as doing good. It will encourage healthy physical activity for the community children.

Club must be current on Rotary International and District Dues.
