Project Title: "Good Night, Sleep Tight" – Morgan County Homeless Coalition

## PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

1. Describe the project. What was done, when, and where did project activities take place?

The Morgan County Homeless Coalition recently leased a building in downtown Berkeley Springs and is renovating the space for a year-round homeless shelter. The anticipated opening date of the new, 10-bed shelter is Spring of 2023. The Berkeley Springs Rotary Club purchased new furniture, specifically a large folding table and 10 chairs, for the new shelter. This facility will provide a safe and comfortable temporary space for the local homeless population.

**2.** Who were the beneficiaries, how were they impacted by this project, and what humanitarian need was met? How many people benefited from this project?

While the numbers have not been tabulated for the current year/winter season, in 2021, Morgan County Homeless Coalition volunteers staffed temporary jousting during the winter months (December 1, 2021 to March 1, 2022) and had 839 "bed nights". With the new shelter planned as a year-round facility, the number of people served and "bed nights" are expected to increase significantly.

**3.** How many Rotarians participated in the project? What did they do? Please give at least two examples, not including financial support provided to the project.

Four Berkeley Springs Rotary Club members participated in this project. One member arranged for the Morgan County Homeless Coalition leaders to give a presentation at one of our Rotary Club meetings. Another member worked with the group to determine what furniture was needed and then purchased the furniture. Two other members visited the new shelter space to make sure the furniture was delivered and set-up and met the needs of the homeless shelter.

4. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role?

The Morgan County Homeless Coalition was involved in our project. Leaders of the homeless coalition provided an update on the group's services as well as plans and needs for a year-round facility.
