- 1. The Cameron County Food Pantry, 135 West 4th St., Emporium, PA, provides food boxes to low income families based on size and income on the 4th Tuesday/Wednesday of every month. 6-7 Rotarians will assemble approximately 160-165 boxes on the 4th Monday of each month and pack 60 boxes for the food distribution on the 4th Tuesday for the High Rise and Maple St. apartments. The remaining boxes are filled by community members throughout the year on Tuesday evening for Wednesday distribution. Several of our members volunteer throughout the year on Tuesday evening or Wednesday.
- 2. Approximately 160-165 low income families from Cameron County will benefit from this project. With the rising price of food, this will help families have more food for the month. It will bring goodwill in our community.
- 3. 6-7 Rotarians will help assemble the boxes and pack boxes on the 4th Monday of every month and several Rotarians will help distribute boxes on the 4th Wednesday of every month.
- 4. Northern Tier Community Action employee, Dave Malize and Father Paul Siebert from St. Marks Catholic Church, oversees the operation of the Cameron County Food Pantry.
