Project Title: President's Playground Improvement Project

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

1. Describe the project. What was done, when, and where did project activities take place?

The club donated funds to the Borough to be used to purchase amenities for the Indian Park Southern Playground Redevelopment. The Borough will purchase a bench and bike rack to be installed by a contractor they will retain for the construction. The Borough just received notice they were awarded a grant from the Commonwealth to proceed with the project (see attached letter). They will be soliciting bids for construction this spring with construction to follow in the summer or fall of 2023.

2. Who were the beneficiaries, how were they impacted by this project, and what humanitarian need was met? How many people benefited from this project?

The beneficiaries are the citizens of the Borough of Montoursville as well as citizens of the County of Lycoming as Indian Park is one of the most visited parks in the County. The project provides needed recreational facilities to promote healthy exercise and socialization. Exact figures are not possible, but we estimate it would be thousands based on the heavy use of the park.

3. How many Rotarians participated in the project? What did they do? Please give at least two examples, not including financial support provided to the project.

Rotarians did not participate in the project, directly, since the Borough is required to solicit bids and retain a qualified contractor in accordance with the conditions of the grant. As a result, This is not a project permitting volunteer participation; however, the Borough informed us there may be opportunity to assist with site preparation and demolition before their contractor mobilizes. Rotarians will be offered opportunity to participate in this way.

4. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role?

The Borough of Montoursville is the organization receiving funds through a grant from the Commonwealth, which along their matching funds and donations from other groups such as Rotary, will make the project possible. They will be soliciting quotes and overseeing all aspects of the project.
