WHAT IS ROTARY?

Rotary is a global network of 1.2 million neighbors, friends, leaders, and problem-solvers who see a world where people unite and take action to create lasting change - across the globe, in our communities and in ourselves.

Rotary values diversity and celebrates the contributions of people of all backgrounds, regardless of their age, ethnicity, race, color, religion, socioeconomic status, culture, sex, sexual orientation, and gender identity.

Many clubs have international programs providing clean water, health care, educational support and more to developing communities around the world, including right here in our own backyard.

And when we combine our forces, we can do the impossible! In the mid-1980's, Rotary started an initiative to eradicate polio. It was a battle the World Health Organization said couldn't be won. But Rotary forged ahead, and eventually the WHO joined us, followed by the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation, UNICEF, and the CDC.

For over 30 years Rotarians have spanned the globe dripping the vaccine into the mouths of children. We are down to active polio cases in just two remaining countries. Rotary is very close to wiping out a crippling disease from the face of our planet.



SATELLITE CLUBS

Rotary recently launched the "*Innovative Clubs Initiative*" to provide a variety of club models that gives the freedom to design a club that works for members' lifestyles and schedules.

One of these initiatives is Satellite clubs, which offers community members, business leaders, and current Rotarians the opportunity to start a new club which fits their need to serve that is not currently met through a "traditional club".

Satellite clubs can:

Attract members who have different vocations or service interests

Be a more affordable club experience

Provide an alternative meeting experience or format where members can experiment with different forms of club organization

STARTING A SATELLITE CLUB

Satellite clubs start at the club level, as their sponsor. Members of the Satellite club will be identified at Rotary international as members of the sponsor club, but have the autonomy to structure the club based upon their members' wishes and desires.

Satellite clubs need at least eight members to become chartered. Good prospects can come from groups in the community who are underrepresented in nearby Rotary clubs: retired people, young professionals, community interest organizations, Rotary program alumni, former members, friends and family.

Your satellite club can be a new group with a different variety of vocations and interests which include Educators, First-responders, Corporations, etc. Current Rotarians who find it hard to be engaged in their current club might also want an opportunity to bring their skills and knowledge to a new satellite club.
