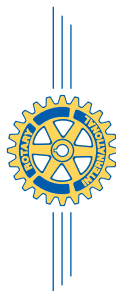

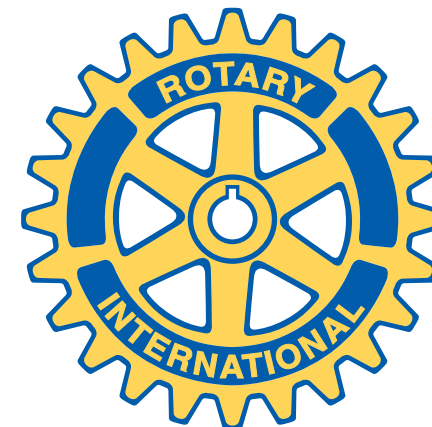

"I need money" with folks wired out of state/country. Calling you on the phone saying they are First Commonwealth- asking for account number. Amazon as a well- have you download an app? And can see your phone and your bank information. People are too trusting, targets seniors. Gift card scam- email asking you to deposit check and send me the amount in gift cards. It turns out to be a fraudulent check. If you display a graphic on your calendar we will send you a check and you keep a portion and send some back- fraudulent. Unemployment voice recognition allowing for accounts to be opened. How to verify- they shouldn't be asking for accounts. Let unknown numbers leave a message. Don't say yes this is "your name" on the phone. Check spelling in emails received. Set up alerts on credit for alerts to potential scammers. The bad guys are getting trickier.
