They offer Pre- apprenticeships geared toward high school juniors and seniors. Basics of blueprint reading, hand tools, power tools construction math rigging materials handling OSHA10 certification with eligibility to work as a laborer for a construction company.

They offer 10 different skilled programs beyond high school 2–4-year program. Depending on the skills. Students are put through the training by their employer contractor. Earn while you're learning. Day time courses. 3 days at the facility per month and the rest on the job site training. Safety training and services.
