

Program: Tim Balconi introduced our speaker, Dr. Rodney J. Landreneau, who has lived in the area for one year. He is Professor of surgery in the Department of Cardiothoracic Surgery at the University of Pittsburgh. Dr. Landrenau spoke on the topic of Lung Cancer Early Diagnosis. He shared the trend on early screening for Lung cancer. Lung cancer causes more deaths than any other cancers. Pa is #10 in the U.S. for deaths from this disease. The U.S. and China have the highest number of deaths from lung cancer. There can be a 20 length of time between smoking and lung cancer development. When someone quits smoking, their risk for cancer drops significantly. There is a 90% success rate when early screening and detection are used. Screening is recommended for those over 55 with a significant history of smoking and it is covered by insurances.
