

Fred and his brother were the partners until 1979 when Fred purchased his brother's interest in the business. In 1981 Fred Jr became a partner. Imler's has worked with Kentucky Fried Chicken for many years having stores ranging from 78 stores to a high of 190 stores. Just to give you a quick idea of the volume, last Thursday and Friday alone they hauled 18 trailer loads of food, each trailer having 40,000 to 42,000 pounds of food per truck. Imler's has 180 + employees, 63 trucks and 99 drivers.
