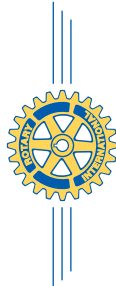

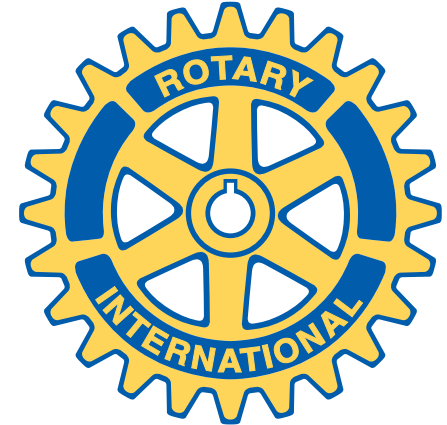

The small company that was started by Don's grandfather has grown to 45 quarries, 31 blacktop facilities and 19 concrete facilities in Pa and NY. The company values at \$820 million and employs 2200. They bid work in 6 regions with 70% public work and 30% private. They serve PennDOT, the turnpike and local government entities. They are currently backlogged with the amount of roadwork bid.
